

Macbeth End of Unit Assessment Options

Solo Options:

- Create a collage that displays at least one of the themes of the plays. Along with the collage you will need to turn in a 1-2 page narrative in MLA format explaining your work. Your collage will use pictures and art to show the feelings and motifs of the play. No larger than poster board size or complete digitally. You will need to be prepared to present to the class and explain.
- Create diary entries for both Macbeth and Lady Macbeth for each act in the play. Total of 10 (5 acts, 5 for Macbeth & 5 for Lady Macbeth). Each diary entry should fully address the important events of each act through the perspectives of the characters writing them. Diary entries must be typed and formatted to look like a diary. Will need to present at least 1 entry from each character to the class and explain.

Solo or Paired Options:

- Creative writing- write an alternative ending to the play. Be prepared to present or at least explain. Your new act should cover significant points to wrap up any new information. You must have a one-paragraph explanation at the end of your assignment explaining why you choose this new ending.
- Rewrite one scene from the play using modern language and themes. Be prepared to explain! Your rewrite will need to cover and address all important events in the scene. You must have a one-paragraph explanation at the end of your assignment explaining why you added or eliminated details.

Group of no more than 4:

- iMovie:
 - Creative writing- write an alternative ending to the play. Your new act should cover significant points to wrap up any new information. You must have a one-paragraph explanation at the end of your assignment explaining why you choose this new ending. Create an iMovie acting your new scene out to be presented.
 - Rewrite one scene from the play using modern language and themes. Your rewrite will need to cover and address all important events in the scene. You must have a one-paragraph explanation at the end of your assignment explaining why you added or eliminated details. Create an iMovie acting your new scene out to be presented.
